General Instructions for Candidates

All candidates appearing for the DPAT Entrance Test scheduled on **02nd August 2026** are requested to carefully read and follow the instructions given below.

Examination Details

- **Mode of Examination:** Online Remote Proctored Examination
- **Examination Location:** Candidates may appear for the examination from their home or any suitable location.
- **Duration:** One Hour (60 Minutes)
- **Login Time:** 20 Minutes before the scheduled examination time.
- **Examination Time:** As notified on DPGU website at <https://dpgu.edu.in/dpat.aspx>
- **System Requirements:** A Desktop, Laptop, or Smartphone/Tablet with a functional camera, microphone, and a stable internet connection.

General Instructions

- Keep a valid Government-issued Photo Identity Card ready for verification (**e.g., Aadhaar Card, PAN Card, Passport, Driving Licence, or Voter ID Card**).
- Ensure you are seated **alone in a quiet, well-lit room** throughout the examination.
- Remain seated and keep your face clearly visible throughout the examination. Do not switch browser tabs, use unauthorized devices or study materials, or repeatedly look away from the screen.
- Your **webcam, microphone, and screen activity** will be monitored throughout the examination.
- Any unfair practice, impersonation, or unauthorized assistance during exam is not allowed.
